

Jacket Care

Boathouse Jacket Laundering Instructions

General Care

- Hang all wet garments to dry after use in rain, or wash.
- Do not leave wet garments balled up in bag or locker.

Washing

- Jackets should be washed in cold water. Rinse temperature should not exceed wash cycle by more than 10 degrees.
- Wash with mild detergent (pH under 10.0) i.e. Ivory or Biz.
- Do not use chlorine bleach or any form of bleaching agent, whitener, brightener or laundry booster.

Drying

- For best results jacket should be hung to drip dry. When tumble drying use lowest temperature or air setting.
- Remove jacket immediately after drying.

DO NOT DRY CLEAN

Restoring water-repellency

After numerous washings or exposures to rain you may notice the water is not "beading" as much on the fabric. The Teflon HT finish is not gone; it's simply absorbed into the shell fabric. To restore the "beading" quality simply place the jacket in a dryer on medium temperature (100 degrees) for 10 minutes or iron your garment at very low temperature with a towel between the garment and the iron.
